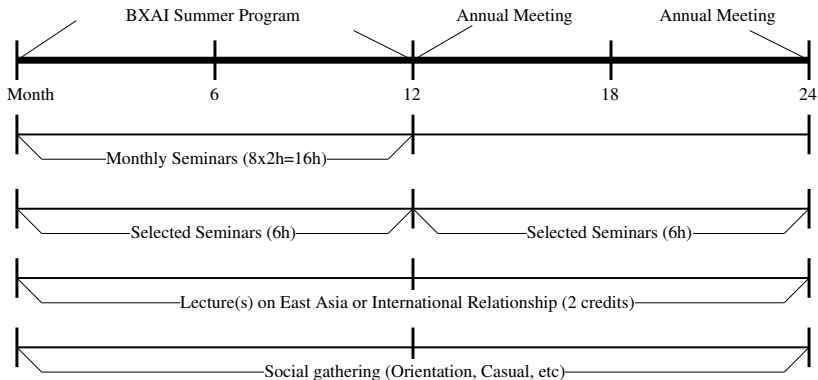

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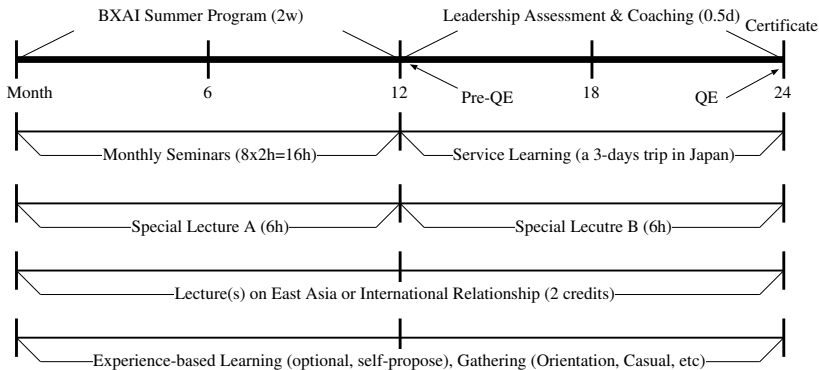
AFLSP@KU Enrichment Program 1st Stage (before Oct 2019)



- Activities with Japanese: Annual Meeting and Lecture
- Activities with Alumni: Social gathering
- Japanese language (optional but strongly recommended)



AFLSP@KU Enrichment Program 2nd Stage (after Oct 2019)



- Activities with Japanese: Pre-QE/QE, Lectures, Learning and Gatherings
- Activities with Alumni: Pre-QE/QE, Service Learning, Lectures, Gatherings
- Japanese language is optional but strongly recommended.
- Note: Summer Program provided by BXAI is included for completeness.



Certificate of completion

- Proof of the completion of the high-quality AFLSP@KU
- Issued for who complete/passed the following programs:
 - ① Orientation in the same year of the enrollment
 - ② Monthly Seminars (16h or more. 1st year)
 - ③ BXA Summer Program (provided by BXA)
 - ④ Special Lectures and Selected Seminars (6h/y × 2y)
 - ⑤ 2-credits Lecture on intl. relations (Asia-focused) or comparative studies of cross-cultural issues in CJK
 - ⑥ Service Learning (2nd year)
 - ⑦ Leadership Assessment & Coaching (2nd year)
 - ⑧ Pre-QE & QE (end of each year)
 - ⑨ (Optional but strongly recommended) Experience-based Learning, casual gathering, Japanese language, etc



1. Orientation

2. Monthly Seminar

- Purpose: Help understand the diversity, identify issues, communicate with others and execute
- Eight times \times 2h = 16h (Usually 10am-12am, Sat)
- Duty to scholars in the 1st year
- Recommended to scholars in the 2nd year
- Each time two or three presentations
- Each presentation consists of report for research (at least half time), culture/social activities and thinking on issues in East Asia or intl. relations.
- Others shall think together with the speaker and discuss after the presentation.



3. BXAI Summer Program (provided by BXAI)

See BXAI's website (mainly for 1st year scholars).



4. Special Lectures and Selected Seminars

- Purpose: Help understand the diversity and consider issues relevant to East Asia.
- 6h/year × 2 years
- Special Lectures are lectures and seminars specially designed for scholars.
- Who missed a Special Lecture (with a strong reason) can propose an alternative Selected Seminar (requires the approval by the committee).



5. 2-credits Lecture

- 2-credits Lecture(s) provided by Kyoto University
- On intl. relations (Asia-focused) or comparative studies of cross-cultural issues in East Asia (China, Japan, Korea)
- Should select one from the list provided by AFLSP@KU, or propose one and get the approval by the committee before the lecture registration.



6. Service Learning (SL)

- Purpose: Discover culture diversity, communicate with others, identify issues and propose appropriate solutions.
- Content: A 3-days study trip in Japan
- Mainly for 2nd year scholars
- Submit an individual research paper on East Asia or intl. relations after the trip.
- Who missed it (with a strong reason) can propose an Experience-Based Learning as alternative (requires the approval by the committee).



7. Leadership Assessment & Coaching

- Purpose: Help discover and develop oneself
- A half day event
- Mainly for 2nd year scholars



8. Pre-QE & QE (Qualification Examination)

- Pre-QE for the 1st year, QE for the 2nd year
- Winter for who enrolled in April and Summer for who enrolled in October
- All scholars are required to join the final presentation
- Evaluation by annual activities with the following criteria
 - Quality of research (evaluated by supervisor)
 - Research review (evaluated by QE board members)
 - Bird's view on issues in the world (Asia preferred)
 - Sociality (culture, intl. relation, communication etc)
 - Leadership (self-leadership, group leadership, etc)



9. Experience-Based Learning (EBL)

- Optional.
- Purpose: same as SL, thus can be an alternative of SL
- Maximum funding: 50,000 Yen \times 10 scholars a year (tentative, depending on the budget and #proposals)
- Submit your proposal at least one month before departure
- Can be combined with a business trip or national/oversea internship
- Submit an individual research paper on East Asia or intl. relations after the trip.
